

Överblick på kommande sidor

- I typfallet är det följande information som skall rapporteras.

Sedan *finns* det vissa undantag för hur vissa stödtyper skall rapporteras på vissa stödposter, detta gäller exempelvis för skattestöd, VC-stöd, och stöd som ges via intermediärer.

Save as

”SA Case Number or Title”: Statsstödsnumret, börjar oftast med ”SA.” och följs alltid av fem siffror. Ni som har gjort den vanliga (årliga) statsstödsrapporteringen känner igen dessa nummer.

Som exempel så har *stödordningen* Sjöfartsstödet numret ”SA.38240”. Enskilda *beviljade* stöd under denna stödordning skall följaktligen registreras med:

”SA Case Number or Title” = ”SA.38240”.

”Beneficiary name”: Namnet på den ”omedelbara mottagaren”. Litegrand godtyckligt.

Det som är viktigt och de facto identifierar mottagaren är:

”EU VAT no” eller **”Beneficiary National Identifier”**.

Det första är ett EU-gemensamt ”organisationsnummer”, det senare är det faktiska svenska organisationsnumret.

”Type” (of enterprise):

Här kommer man att kunna välja mellan SME och stort företag.

SME definieras som följer:

Omsättning

Balansomslutning

Enterprise category	Headcount: Annual Work Unit (AWU)	Annual turnover	Or	Annual balance sheet
Medium-sized	< 250	≤ €50 million	Or	≤ €43 million
Small	< 50	≤ €10 million	Or	≤ €10 million
Micro	< 10	≤ €2 million	Or	≤ €2 million

”Region (NUTS2)”

Den NUTS2-region där stödbeviljad aktivitet befinner sig.

”Sector (NACE)”

Bara en sektor kan väljas, och det ska vara den som bedöms mest relevant för den aktivitet som stödet beviljats.

”Aid Instrument”

Annex III of GBER lists as possible aid instruments to publish in the Transparency Award Module: Grant/Interest rate subsidy, Loan/Repayable advances/Reimbursable grant, Guarantee, Tax advantage or tax exemption, Risk finance, Other (please specify).

If the aid is granted through multiple aid instruments, the aid amount shall be provided by instrument (footnote 4 to Annex III of GBER).

”Objective” (Syfte)

För varje beviljat stöd (som skall transparensredovisas) skall *ett* syfte anges. Dessa väljs utifrån en lista med standardiserade ”syften”.

”Date Granted”

Beviljandedatum eller datumet då del legala rätten till stöd tilldelas förmånstagaren.

”Currency”

Samma summa skrivs i normalfallet både på nominellt belopp och stödbelopp. Vi redovisar i SEK; ECB-länk gör att vi får växlingen till EUR automatiskt.

”Granting Authority Name”

Namnet på den nationella auktoritet/myndighet/organisation som beviljar stödet.
